EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Article 65 of the Staff Regulations requires the Council to undertake an annual review of the remunerations of officials on the basis of real net changes in remunerations in national civil services as measured by the specific indicator, and in accordance with the detailed rules for applying Article 65 spelled out in the method for adjusting the remuneration of officials and other servants of the Communities adopted on 15 December 1981.
2. On 19 December 1983 the Council, on the basis of the SOEC annual report establishing the specific indicator at - 0.3, adopted a Regulation No 3647/83 adjusting salary scales with effect from 1 July 1983.
3. At the end of 1984 the SOEC corrected its annual report for 1983, since it had been unable to allow for Italian legislation which altered certain elements in calculation. The effect of this correction was to raise the specific indicator for 1983 to + 0.4. The consequential adjustments to salary scales established following the 1983 annual review were made by Council Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 419/85 of 18 February 1985.
4. Following a retroactive change in German tax legislation the SOEC has again corrected its calculations on the basis of figures supplied by the Federal authorities. The final specific indicator for 1983 now stands at + 0.5.

This latest correction represents an additional increase of 0.1% with effect from 1 July 1983. It is proposed that it be applied linearly.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single
Commission of the European Communities,

Having regard to the Protocol on the Privileges and Immunities of the European
Communities, and in particular Article 13 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of
Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities laid down by Regulation
(EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68,¹ as last amended by Regulation (ECSC, EEC,
Euratom) No 420/85,² and in particular Articles 63, 64, 65 and 82 of the Staff
Regulations and the first paragraph of Article 20 and Article 64 of the
Conditions of Employment,

Having regard to Council Decision 81/1061/Euratom, ECSC, EEC of 15 December 1981
amending the method of adjusting the remuneration of officials and other
servants of the Communities,³

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Regulations (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 419/85⁴ and (ECSC, EEC, Euratom)
No 420/85² were not able to take account of factors arising from certain
amendments to German legislation affecting civil servants' salaries; whereas
the effect of these factors could not be estimated before the Regulations were
adopted;

Whereas the amounts laid down by Regulations (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 419/85 and
(ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 420/85 should therefore be corrected;
