THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities, and in particular Article 24 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities laid down by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68 (¹), as last amended by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2951/97 (²), and in particular Article 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations and Articles 22 and 67 of the Conditions of Employment,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission presented after consulting the Staff Regulations Committee,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (3),

Having regard to the opinion of the Court of Justice,

Having regard to the opinion of the Court of Auditors,

Whereas daily subsistence allowance rates for officials on mission for Austria, Finland and Sweden should be incorporated into Article 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations is amended as follows:

1. The following is inserted in the scale in paragraph 1(a):


